10th	Pray for those in our church community who are currently out of work and are searching for a job. Pray for God's provision, guidance and patience at this time.
11th	That we all take time to consider our talents and that the Lord helps us to use them wisely to further his kingdom.
12th	Pray for the ongoing and future ministry of Coffee Pot, a time for mothers and toddlers to meet together for play, prayer, study, fellowship and fun (Thursday mornings).
14th	Thank God for our team of dedicated Sunday School teachers and that God will give them wisdom and love as they help our children to grow in His grace.
15th	Pray for the OYM team as they lead today's service at St Mark's. Pray that God would give them creativity and wisdom as they aim to communicate to all ages in the service.
16th	Thank God for our team of youth group leaders and helpers. Pray for new female team members to come forward and fill the gaps.
